2nd largest barrier island on U.S. east coast


12 x 5 miles

- AA+ credit rating from S&P











PSD Water Demand


- Average daily demand:
 5 6 mgd (million gallons per day)
- Peak day demand:10-11 mgd
- Total annual water demand: Approx. 2.3 billion gallons
