Meeting Summary (May 15th)

The Saluda RBC Chair, KC Price, called the May 15th meeting of the Saluda RBC to order at 10:00 AM. The fourteenth meeting of the Saluda RBC was held in-person and virtually via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. Including the Saluda RBC members and planning team, there were 42 people present at this RBC meeting in-person and online. KC discussed the agenda items for the meeting. The Saluda RBC approved the RBC meeting agenda. Approval of the April minutes and summary documents were tabled until the June meeting. A public comment period was held with no formal comments received. An agency comment period was held with no comments received. John Boyer reviewed the April meeting highlights.

John Boyer and Elliot Wickham, CDM Smith and SCDNR SCO, presented information related to drought management and response. Drought management and response was broken out into 3 parts for the meeting. In part 1, John reviewed the RBC's drought obligations and outline of Chapter 8 of the river basin plan. Elliot Wickham presented on the differences between the Drought Response Committee and US Drought Monitor processes and outcomes.

After a break, John and Elliot continued discussion of drought management and response - part 2. John reviewed utility drought plans and Elliot provided an overview of the Drought Planning Guidebook. The guidebook is a tool to assist water utilities in updating their drought plans.

Finally, John Boyer led discussion on part 3 of drought management and response. The RBC went through communication strategies and considered the development of drought management or response strategies. The RBC members discussed particular drought recommendations and decided to keep two, toss one, and tabled two others for future discussion.

The RBC meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the Saluda RBC will be June 19th at the Greenville Water Community Room in Greenville, SC.
